If a candidate desires to use or raise campaign funds to repay himself or herself for personal funds which he or she contributed to the campaign, then he or she would need to report those personal funds as a loan in Section 12.

Instead, they would be reported as a campaign contribution either in Section 16 or on line 18, depending upon the amount.

Candidates ending their campaign in debt are permitted to raise funds to retire the debt subject to the restrictions contained in Ark. Code Ann. § 7-6-219.
