IMPORTANT

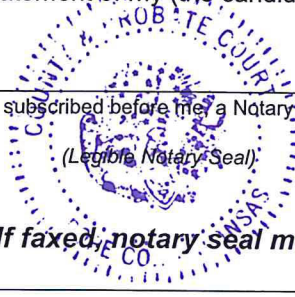

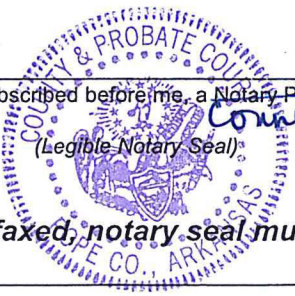
